Installation

Before installing PocketLingo 2.0, please make sure that your Palm OS device meets the System Requirements mentioned above. PocketLingo contains three files that need to be installed: program file, database file, and zLib file.

1. zLib file (SysZLib.prc - 71KB) must be installed onto your Palm OS device.
2. Program file (PocketLingo2.prc - 400KB) can be installed on either your device or on the memory card.
3. Database file (*see Appendix B for a list of filenames*) can be installed on either your device or on the memory card. To install the database file to your memory card, please use the instructions below.

Installing PocketLingo Using a Windows Computer

1. Download the PocketLingo zip file (*see Appendix A for a list of zip filenames*) into the Add-on folder in your Palm Desktop directory on your computer and extract the .zip file.
2. Double-click the Palm Desktop icon on your desktop or open it from the Start Menu.
3. Click **Install**.
Tip: You can also access the Install Tool dialog by clicking on the .prc file.
4. From the User pop-up menu, select your user name.
5. Click **Add**.
6. When the Open dialog box appears, select PocketLingo2.prc as well as the database file (*see Appendix B for a list of filenames*).
NOTE: SysZLib.prc MUST be installed on the device.
7. Click **Open**.
8. Click **Add File** to add PocketLingo to the Install Handheld Files List. If you would like to install the files to the memory card, please do the following (**NOTE: SysZLib.prc MUST be installed on the device.**):
 - a. Click **Change Destination**. In the Change Destination box, select the files and click on the >> arrows to move the files to the box on the right hand side, which should have the name of the memory card on top.
 - b. Click **OK**.
9. Click **Done** to close the Install Tool window.
10. Perform a HotSync operation to install PocketLingo.

Installing PocketLingo Using a Macintosh

1. Download the PocketLingo zip file (*see Appendix A for a list of zip filenames*) into the Add-on folder in your Palm Desktop directory on your computer and extract the .zip file.
2. Double-click the HotSync Manager icon in the Palm folder.
3. From the HotSync menu, choose Install Handheld Files.
4. From the User pop-up menu, select your user name.

5. Click **Add to List**.
6. Select the Add-on folder from the popup menu.
7. When the Open dialog box appears, select PocketLingo2.prc, SysZLib.prc and the database file (*see Appendix B for a list of filenames*).
NOTE: SysZLib.prc MUST be installed on the device.
8. Click **Open**.
9. Click **Add File** to add PocketLingo to the Install Handheld Files List. If you would like to install the files to the memory card, please do the following (**NOTE: SysZLib.prc MUST be installed on the device.**):
 - a. Click **Change Destination**. In the Change Destination box, select the files and click on the >> arrows to move the files to the box on the right hand side, which should have the name of the memory card on top.
 - b. Click **OK**.
10. Close the Install Handheld Files window.
11. Perform a HotSync operation to install PocketLingo.

Uninstalling PocketLingo

1. From your Palm's main Application Launcher, tap the Menu button and select Delete from the drop down list.
2. Tap PocketLingo 2.0 and then tap Delete.
3. Tap Yes to confirm you wish to remove the program. PocketLingo should no longer appear on your screen.

Note: If you have other PocketLingo 2.0 software (*see the System Requirements section above for a list of titles*), please delete only the database file from your memory card. Deleting all the PocketLingo files may require you to re-install other PocketLingo products.

The Registration Code - What, Where, and How

The Registration Code is a combination of letters and numbers. The registration code consists of the numbers 0-9 and letters A-F only (for example: 1D35FC67A1). To enter your Registration Code:

1. Start PocketLingo and select the dictionary you wish to register on the Lookup screen.
2. Go to **Menu > Help > Registration**.
3. Type your Registration Code into the PocketLingo registration screen.
(If you are installing more than one PocketLingo title, you will need to repeat these instructions and enter the correct registration code for each new title.)
4. Tap **Register** to continue or **Not Yet** to quit the registration process. If you quit, you may return later to register the product. The full dictionary will only be available after you have entered the correct Registration Code and completed the registration process by tapping **Register** on the registration screen.



Using PocketLingo for PalmOS

Overview

PocketLingo's main view contains the following objects:

	Tap on this bar to display the Edit and Help menus.
	<i>Back graphic</i> button Allows you to return to the previously viewed screen.
	<i>Home</i> button Brings you to the LookUp screen.
	<i>Help</i> button Displays tips on using PocketLingo; the Pronunciation Key and Abbreviation submenus are also located here.
	<i>Information</i> button Provides contact and copyright information.
	<i>Search query field</i> Enter the word you would like to look up.
	<i>Eraser</i> button Deletes the entry in the Search query field.
	Font size button Choose between large or regular fonts.
	<i>View select</i> button Choose between the normal and full index views of the word list.
	<i>Previous</i> button (<i>definition display view</i>) Loads the definition for the previous entry
	<i>Next</i> button (<i>definition display view</i>) Loads the definition for the next entry

The scroll bar is used to move the content on the screen up and down. Here are its features:

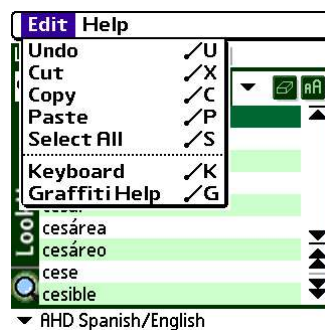
	<i>Page up</i> button
	<i>Page down</i> button
	<i>Scroll up</i> button Scrolls the definition up one line
	<i>Scroll down</i> button Scrolls the definition down one line

The **Tips**, **Abbreviation**, **Registration** and **About PocketLingo** screens can be found by tapping on **PocketLingo** then **Help**; or go to **Menu > Help** in Palm's program menu.

Lookup Tab

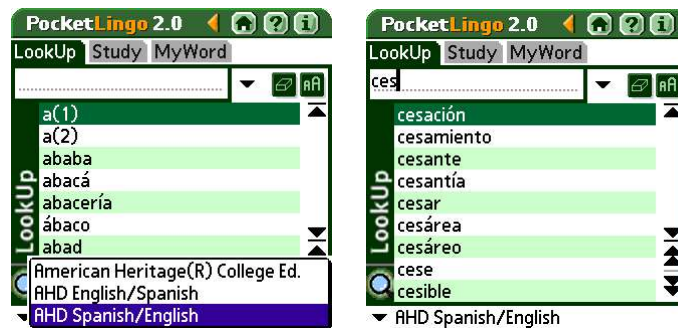
1. To search for a word, type it into the Search query field and a list of possible matches will be displayed below.
2. Tap the word you want on the list.
Tip: You can also enter your query using the standard keyboard of your handheld device.

If you have a word in your clipboard, you can paste it into the query field by tapping on **PocketLingo** or going to your handheld's menu and using the paste function.



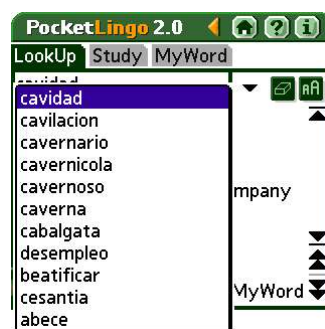
Switching Dictionary

If you have more than one dictionary installed for PocketLingo, you can switch from one to another by tapping on the dictionary title bar at the bottom of the screen and selecting the dictionary you would like to view from the drop-down list.



History

If you are looking up a word you have looked up recently, click on the arrow next to the search query field. PocketLingo will show up to 20 recently looked up words in each dictionary.

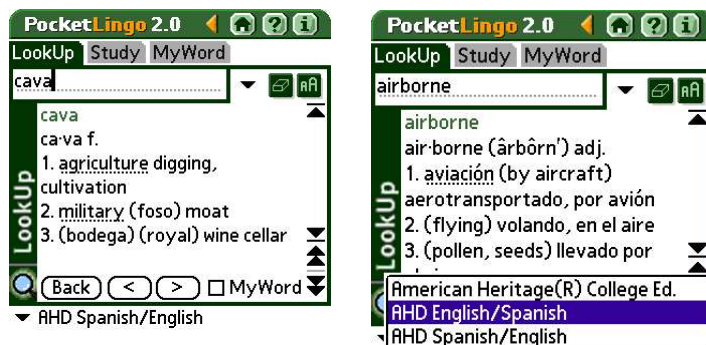


If you want to start another search, tap the eraser button, which will erase the current contents of the search query field. Alternately, you can use the backspace key on the keyboard to erase one character at a time.



Definition

The definition will be displayed after tapping the word in the **LookUp** screen. Use the scroll buttons to view the entire definition.

If you have more than one PocketLingo reference titles, you can switch to the other reference title by tapping on the title bar at the bottom of the screen and selecting the appropriate reference title to view the definition in the other title.






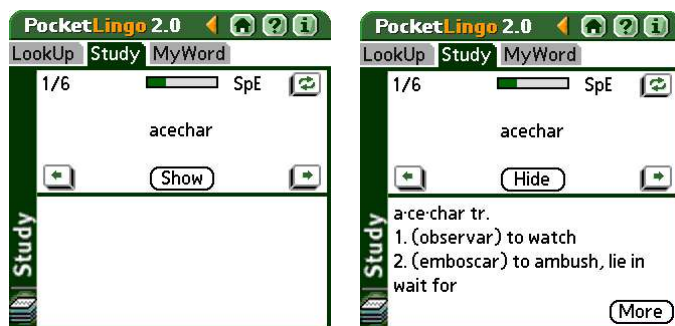
If you would like to add the word to the MyWord list, check on the MyWord box, as shown here: ☒ My Word. The **Back** button will return you to the term list.


To view the next entry word's definition, click the Next button (). To view the previous entry word's definition, click the Previous button ().

Study Tab








The Study function is designed to help you build a more powerful vocabulary. It is similar to but much more powerful than a written study card.

1. Tap on the Show / Hide button to show or hide the definition of the word.
2. Tap on the More button to bring up a complete definition of the word.
3. Use the  button to review the previous word, the  button to review the next word on the list, and the  button to review a random word from the MyWord list.



Note: The Goal Bar  shows how long the word has been on the list.


Study Control

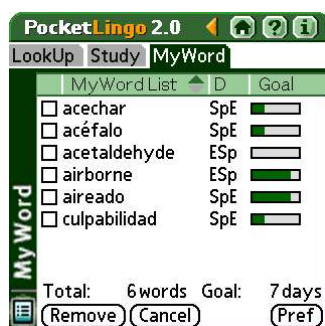
	<i>Previous</i> button Moves to previous word on the list.
	<i>Next</i> button Moves to next word on the list.
	<i>Shuffle</i> button Shuffles the words on the list.
	<i>Goal</i> Bar Indicates how close you are to your goal.
	<i>Show</i> button Shows the definition of the word.
	<i>Hide</i> button Hides the definition of the word.
	<i>More</i> button Brings up a complete definition of the word.

MyWord Tab


MyWord displays the complete list of words that you have selected to save. This allows you to see in a quick glance all the words you plan to study. You can save up to 1000 words in this list.

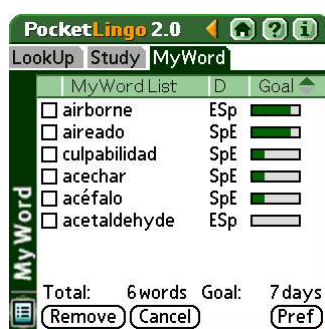
To see the definition of a particular word, just tap on the word in the list. You may use the scroll bar to view the entire list.


To sort the list in alphabetical (ascending or descending) order, tap on .

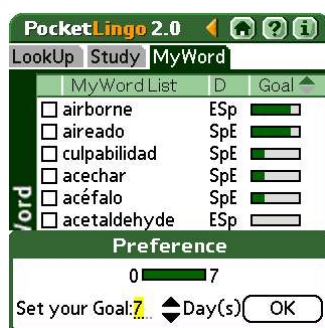



If you have more than one PocketLingo title installed, you can sort the list by each database. To do so, tap on “D” next to “MyWord List”

To sort the list by how long the words have been on the list, tap on 









The  button allows you to set a goal for how quickly you want to learn the words on your list. The darkened portion of the Goal Bar indicates how long the word has been on the list and allows you to see how close you are to your goal.



To remove a word from the list, first tap the check box next to the word, and then tap the  button.

MyWord Control

	<i>MyWord List</i> Sorts the list in alphabetical order.
	<i>Dictionary Indicator</i> Sorts the list by which dictionary it is from.
	<i>Goal</i> Sorts the list by how long the words have been on the list.
	<i>Preferences button</i> Sets a goal for how quickly you want to learn the words.
	<i>Goal Bar</i> Indicates how close you are to your goal.
	<i>Remove button</i> Removes a word from the list.

Hardware Specific Features

For the Sony Clié

PocketLingo supports features of the Sony Clié. To use the Jog Dial of the Clié, it needs to be activated in the preferences of the Palm OS.

1. Go to the Preferences screen of Palm OS.
2. Select Jog from the drop down menu.
3. Check the box for 'Use JogAssist'.

The Jog Dial should now work with PocketLingo. You can use the Jog Dial in Lookup, Study and MyWord in the following ways:

Lookup Tab

In Lookup, the Jog Dial's up and down scroll allow you to scroll up and down in the word list one word at a time. When the Jog Dial is pushed in, the definition of the word that is highlighted will appear. In the word definition, when the Jog Dial is pressed down the MyWord box will be checked or unchecked, adding or deleting the word in MyWord List. The back button of the Sony Clié works the same way as the orange back button at the top of the PocketLingo screen.

Study Tab

In Study, the Jog Dial's down scroll allows you to view the next word, the Jog Dial's up scroll goes to the previous word card for your list. Pushing in the Jog Dial is equivalent to tapping the Show/Hide button on the card. The back button of the Sony Clié works the same way as the orange back button at the top of the PocketLingo screen.

MyWord Tab

In MyWord, the Jog Dial's up and down scroll allow you to scroll up and down the MyWord list one word at a time. When the Jog Dial is pushed in, the definition of the word that is highlighted will appear. In the word definition, when the Jog Dial is pushed in, the MyWord box will be checked or unchecked, adding or deleting the word to the MyWord List. The back button of the Sony Clié works the same way as the orange back button at the top of the PocketLingo screen.

Installing on Memory Stick Using MS Import/MS Export

When you are installing PocketLingo on your MemoryStick, please remember to install PocketLingo2.prc, and the database file (*see Appendix B for a list of filenames*) using MS Import/MS Export applications that come with your Clie.

MS Import and MS Export are applications designed to help you copy the data on your computer to the Memory Stick media on your Clie directly without performing a HotSync Operation.

Install PocketLingo to your Memory Stick.

1. Open Palm Desktop application.
2. Click "Install" (The Install Tool dialog box appears.)
3. From the User-drop down list, select your user name.
4. Click Add. (The Open File dialog box appears.)
5. Select the application (SysZLib.prc file)
In the Install Tool dialog box, the file you selected is displayed.
6. Click Done.
7. Click OK.
8. Perform a HotSync operation.
9. Tap "MS Import" application on your Clie. (Make sure your Clie is in the cradle)
10. Open "MS Export" application on your computer.
11. Click "Add" (The Open File dialog box appears.)
Select the application (PocketLingo2.prc and database files)
12. Click "Open"
13. Entry Form dialog opens
14. Type in Application Name
15. Select Palm -> Launcher folder.
16. Confirm that in the MS Export dialog, the files you selected are displayed.
17. Click "Install"
PocketLingo2.prc and database files are now on your memory stick.
18. After the installation is completed, tap "Disconnect" on your Clie's MS Import Screen

Install PocketLingo to your Memory Stick.

(This will start an application automatically when Memory Stick is inserted)

1. Follow the above instructions step 1 – 18.
2. Tap "MSAutorun" on your Clie
3. When the application opens, select Memory Card tab (or select "MS" from the top right drop down arrow.
4. Tap "PocketLingo"
5. Click "Set" (The setting is stored in the Memory Stick, and the confirmation dialog box appears.)
6. Tap "OK"
7. Tap Home to return to the Application Launcher screen.
8. Remove the Memory Stick.
9. Insert the Memory Stick. You will see that Application Launcher screen is displayed and the PocketLingo application starts automatically. When you remove the Memory Stick, the PocketLingo quits automatically and the Application Launcher screen appears.

Troubleshooting

Q: My Registration Key Does Not Work

Q: How do I check available space on my Palm?

To check the space you have on your Palm, please do the following:

1. Tap the Home button on your Palm to bring you to your list of applications.
2. Tap the Menu button, and pull down the "App" menu.
3. Then tap on "Info". Near the top of the screen it should say "Free Space:". The number there is the amount of available space on your Palm.

Q: How do I open the downloaded zip file?

In order to open the file you've downloaded (*see Appendix A for a list of zip filenames*), please "unzip" the file first. We recommend WinZip for Windows users (www.winzip.com) and StuffIt Expander (www.stuffit.com/expander/index.html) for Mac Users.

The zip file contains a number of files, including PocketLingo2.prc, SysZLib.prc, ReadMe.txt, and PocketLingo_2.0_User_Guide_Palm.pdf (User Guide). See Appendix B for a list of database (PDB) files included with each dictionary.

Q: I get an error that says "Dictionary Not Found".

This error occurs when PocketLingo cannot locate a dictionary and usually means that the .pdb files did not install onto your device. Please locate the PocketLingo zip file you downloaded and use your HotSync manager to install the .pdb files to your device.

If you have copied/moved the dictionary file, please remove the program entirely (both from your device and memory card) and follow the installation instructions in the User Guide (page 7).

Instructions on how to do this are in the User Guide (see the Installation section above). You should also check that you have enough space to install the PDB file (see the question: "How do I check available space on my Palm?").

Q: I can't find the PocketLingo icon in my list of applications.

Check to make sure the files properly transferred to your device.

1. Tap the Home button, then the Menu button.
2. Select “Info” from the Apps menu.
3. Scroll down the list of programs that appears.

If PocketLingo 2.0 is not in the list, please follow the instructions in the User Guide to install PocketLingo to your device. You should also check to see if you have enough space to install PocketLingo 2.0 (see the question: “How do I check available space on my Palm?”).
