Installation:

Duck Creek Video Poker will work on any Palm OS device with Palm OS 3.5 or better.

To install, simply use your Palm Desktop program to copy the following files to your device:

- DC Poker.prc (for color devices) or DC Poker BW.prc (for monochrome devices)
- DCcomps.prc (optional)
- NSBSystemLib.prc
- DCsupport1.prc

Please refer to the documentation included with the Palm Desktop for more information on hotsyncing with your device.

If the DCcomps.prc file is not added to your device, you will not see images of your earned comps. This may be beneficial if you are limited on handheld memory space.

Introduction:

Welcome to Duck Creek Casino and some of the best gambling this side of the Bit Stream! Our casino offers one of the most exciting video poker machines around...**Jacks+ Video Poker**. Grab your *players card* and hit the casino floor. \$1000 dollars has been deposited into your casino account. The more you gamble, the more the house will reward you with free comps. Of course, you have to win to continue gambling so it may not be as easy as you think.

Our game can keep track of your winnings and those of up to nine others players. See who really is the best video poker player in your house.

Instructions:

Title Screen

From the Title Screen, tap on the 'Play' button to begin playing the game.

If you are playing the trial version, a 'Register' button will also be visible. Tap the 'Register' button to input your registration code which is sent from Duck Creek Digital Outfitters when your purchase is processed. The trial version of the game is limited to a specified number of deals which will be displayed when you begin playing.



Player Select Screen



The Player Select Screen displays your Duck Creek Casino Players Card. This card will keep track of your player's total cash and a history of comps earned. To select a different player, tap on the down arrowhead next to the visible player's name. You may select one of ten available players.

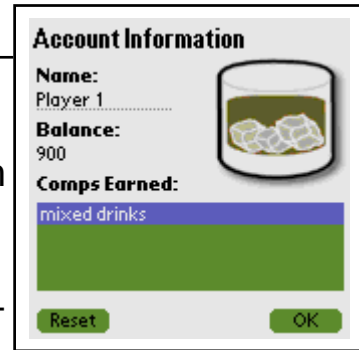
Tap the 'OK' button to begin playing a game using the selected player.

Tap on the 'Info' button to see details regarding the selected player.

Player Info Screen

The Player Info Screen will show information regarding a player's account.

Tap the 'OK' button when you are done viewing the information.



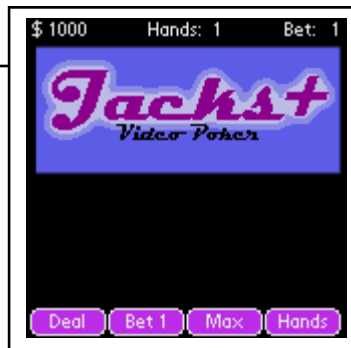
Tap the 'Reset' button to reset your player's account. This may be necessary when your player's account balance has reached zero and you are no longer able to gamble.

To change the name of your player, tap on the player name and edit using the standard Palm text editing methods.

To view an image of an earned comp, tap on the name of the comp. The image will appear in the top right area of the screen. Tap on the image to see details on the comp.

Game Screen

Across the top of the screen you will see (from left to right) your current account balance, number of hands currently playing, and the current bet multiplier.



Main Game Screen you will see (from left to right) your current account balance, number of hands currently playing, and the current bet multiplier.

The bottom of the screen will display the following buttons:

'Deal' - Tap this to deal a hand using the current settings.

'Bet 1' - Tap this to increase your bet multiplier by one. If you reach the maximum of five, the game will automatically deal.

'Max' - Tap this to deal a hand using the maximum bet multiplier of five.

'Hands' - Tap this to increase your number of hands played simultaneously by one. If you reach the maximum of ten, the next tap will roll the hands played back to one.



Once the hand has been dealt, you will see a row of larger cards. This is your main hand. If you are only playing one hand, this will also be your only hand. If you are playing more than one hand, you will see the additional hands displayed above your main hand. These additional hands will initially be blank.

To hold a card just tap on the card. If a card is held, the text 'HOLD' will be displayed underneath. To release a held card, tap it again. In multi-hand play, the held cards will also display in your additional hands.



Press the 'Deal' button again to replace your cards that were NOT held. After the deal is complete (in multi-hand play the system will also deal cards for each of your additional hands) the game will score each hand using traditional

poker hand descriptions. See section on Payout Grid for a description of each payout type. The total hand payoff will be displayed and added to your account total.

Game Menu

To display the game menu, tap the menu area on the silk-screened portion of your PDA device.

Game:

Accounts: takes you to the Player Account Screen.

Options: takes you to the Options Screen.

Quit: exits game. (player progress is automatically saved on exit)

Machine:

\$1 machine

\$5 machine

\$25 machine

\$100 machine: select to change the type of machine currently played. The designated dollar amount will be bet for each hand (times the bet multiplier).

Payout Rate: takes you to the Payout Grid Screen.

Help:

Instructions: abbreviated game instructions.

Register: may be used to register a trial version if registration number has been obtained from the developer.


About: contact information.



Payout Grid Screen

The Payout Grid Screen provides information regarding payout rates for the currently played machine (and bet multiplier).

Poker hands paid out:



Payout Rate	
\$1 machine	Bet 5
Jacks +	5
two pair	10
3 of a kind	15
straight	20
flush	30
full house	45
4 of a kind	125
straight flush	250
royal flush	2500

OK

Jacks+ : a pair of jacks or better (queens, kings, aces)

Two pair: two pair of anything

3 of a kind: three of the same card denomination

Straight: all cards in denomination order (ex. 3,4,5,6,7)

Flush: all cards same suit

Full House: a pair and three of a kind in the same hand

4 of a kind: four of the same card denomination

Straight flush: a straight with all cards of same suit

Royal flush: all cards of same suit with following denominations
(Ace, King, Queen, Jack, Ten)

Game Options Screen



The Game Options Screen will allow you to change the card animation speed and turn the sound effect on/off. These options are automatically saved.

The options are saved universally and cannot be changed for individual players.

Account Interest

The Casino will pay your account interest when you are not playing. In order for this to happen, you must exit the game when you are done gambling for the day. This way the Casino knows you are away and not actually just popping down a few drinks in the bar. When you return to the game (if it has been at least a day), the Casino will issue you an account interest statement which will display the amount of interest you have earned on the money in your account. This may be useful if you are running low and don't want to have to reset your player (which would lose your earned comps).

Casino Comps

The Casino wants to keep you happy. That is why they have a Casino Comp program which will have you earning free goodies (no...you won't be really receiving these, this is only a game, so don't get your hopes up) in no time. The more you play (and the higher your bet multiplier) the more comps you will earn. There is a total of thirteen comps available. Can you collect them all?
