INSTALLATION:

If you don't have the 1.0 or the 1.01 version already installed on your device please consult the manual for installation instructions.

If you have a previous version of the software installed and don't want to lose your saved data (scheduled movies, programs etc.) follow the instruction below:

- 1) Inside of the ZIP file you will find another ZIP file called "PATCH ONLY"
- 2) Inside the patch only zip there's a folder called "TV Guide", extract it
- 3) Connect your Pocket PC to your Desktop PC
- 4) Now that your pocket pc is connected, copy the extracted "TV Guide" folder (copy the folder, NOT the file inside of it) in the "Program Files" folder present on your pocket PC device
- 5) A message will tell you that the folder already exist, click 'Yes to all'

NOTE: Since the uninstall informations remain the same of the previous version, if you use this method some of the new files included in the patch will not be deleted when you unistall the software. You will have to remove them manually.


All the options settings will be reset to default (on) after installing the patch.

THE NEW RECURRENT PROGRAMS FUNCTION

The new version of TV Guide allows you to save your favourite weekly TV programs and movies.

PLEASE NOTE: Some examples and procedures described below refer to the movie screen only. These examples and procedures work in the same way in the program screen.

-The 'R' Page



The recurrent programs and movies that you schedule will be saved in a new separate page, dedicated to recurrent programs only.

So now you have a total of 3 pages per day, allowing you to save up to 6 movies and 12 programs for each day.


To access this page:

- Click the recurrent icon (see below)

OR

- Cycle the pages in the normal way, using the button on the toolbar or tapping the page icon. If there aren't recurrent programs scheduled for the day, the R page will not be accessible in this way.

-The Recurrent Icon



This icon will tell you if there are recurrent movies/programs scheduled for the day.

Tap this icon to jump to the recurrent page (see above) of the current day

-The Recurrent Programs Priority

Recurrent movies/programs have priority over other saved programs. This means that TV guide will show the Recurrent page before the standard ones if there are recurrent programs saved for that day.

You can disable this function from the options screen by unchecking the "Recurrent Priority" checkbox.

-How To Add A Recurrent Movie/Program

Adding recurrent movies/programs is very simple, and works almost identically to adding normal movies and programs.

1) Tap the movie logo to access the movie edit screen. Don't worry the page, the software will automatically copy the movie to the Recurrent page. The only thing to consider is the slot you are occupying, so if you click on the first logo, the recurrent movie will be saved in the first slot of the recurrent page and so on

2) In the movie edit screen enter the movie information and check the "save as recurrent" option (you must close the soft keyboard to see it)

3) Click the OK button in the lower-right corner of the screen


These steps apply to the program screen in the same way

Some things to remember:


-If you access the movie edit screen from the 'R' Page, the "save as recurrent" option will be automatically set to checked and you won't be able to uncheck it. So you can save recurrent movies from standard pages, but cannot save standard movies from the recurrent page.

-If you tap a slot already occupied by another non-recurrent movie don't worry, just enter the information of the recurrent movie you want to save, check the "save as recurrent" option and click OK. The non-recurrent movie informations will not be modified.

-How to delete/edit a recurrent movie/program

Deleting/editing a recurrent movie/program is the same as deleting/editing a standard one:

- 1) In the recurrent page of the selected day, tap the movie/program you want to delete/edit
- 2) In the movie/program edit screen tap the 'Delete Movie' or 'Delete Program' button if you want to delete it, or edit the saved information and click the lower-right Ok button when you have finished

-How to copy a movie/program to the recurrent page

If you want to copy a not-recurrent movie/program to the recurrent page, just tap the movie/program you want to copy. In the movie/program edit screen, check the "save as recurrent" option and click the lower-right corner OK button.

NOTE: The movie/program you are copying will not be deleted from the standard page, you will have to delete it manually

-How to view saved recurrent movies/programs

-If you have the Recurrent Priority option (see page 2) turned on, you'll see the recurrent page before anything else when cycling through days

-Tap the Recurrent Icon (page 2) or swap pages in the normal way to access the recurrent page (this will work only if there are recurrent movies/programs already saved)

THE NEW NOTIFY ICONS FUNCTIONALITY

The notify icons on the right of the screen work in the same way of the previous version except:

- Icons corresponding to the current screen (e.g. Movie icon in the Movie Screen or Program Icon in the Program screen) will not show up if there are only recurrent movies/programs saved for the day. This is useful if you turn on the recurrent priority option and want to see if there are other movies/programs scheduled without switching pages.

If you are viewing the movie screen and there are recurrent programs scheduled for the day, the program notify icon will alert you anyway, and vice versa.

- Tapping the icon corresponding to the current screen (e.g. Movie icon in the Movie Screen or Program Icon in the Program screen) will automatically jump to the first page of the current day occupied by at least one movie/program. This is useful when the recurrent priority option is turned on, to quickly access from the recurrent page, the other movies/programs scheduled for the day.

OTHER CHANGES

- Aligned text in the Movie Insert screen

TROUBLESHOOTING

Q: I tap the page icon or the page button to switch pages but I can't access the recurrent page

A: You can't access the recurrent page if there aren't recurrent movies/programs saved for the day

Q: How can I insert a recurrent movie/program if I can't access the Recurrent page until I haven't inserted one?

A: Recurrent movies/programs can be added from the standard pages 1 and 2, just remember to check the "save as recurrent" option in the movie/program edit screen

Q: I can't disable the "save as recurrent" option

A: You are trying to save a non-recurrent movie/program from the recurrent page, this is not allowed. You can save only recurrent movies/programs from the recurrent page.

Q: There are recurrent movies/programs scheduled for the day but the movie/program notify icon won't show!

A: see "The new notify icons functionality" above

STILL KNOWN ISSUES

- Leap years are not supported. You may experience date problems in the month of February during these years.
(errors will automatically correct at the next March)
- There are no controls on the size of the custom logos. Too big or too small bitmaps may cause graphical issues.
Please respect the standard size of 49 x 64 pixels
- The little ok button in the top-right corner is a little tricky and sometimes it doesn't work as it should
- Installing the software on a storage card may result in poor performance, please install the software in the main memory
