What are Avatars and how do you use them?

AVATARS Avatars are little images that are created to work in your address book. Many times you do not have time to take pictures of people in your address book. Sometimes pictures are not appropriate such as an organization or company. Avatars provide the perfect way to visually organize an entry in your address book.



Avatars come in a variety of subjects and categories including objects, services, occupations, and faces.

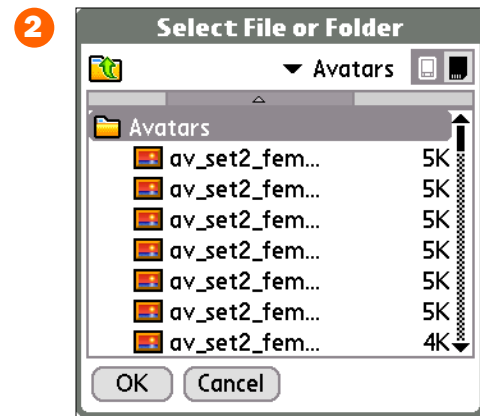
Avatars are large and detailed. Unlike photos, Avatars are general enough to be appropriate for a number of types of contacts.

How do you install Avatars?

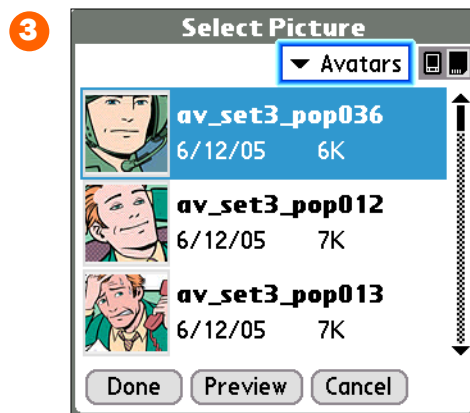
Avatars are actually very simple to install. The first step is to get the Avatars to your handheld. This requires a Memory Card. Put the Avatars somewhere on the memory card. Once on the card you will want to use them with your Palm OS contacts. Here is how:



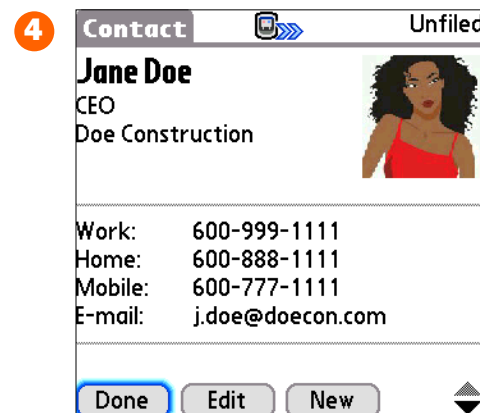
Edit your contact. Click on the box named "Picture".



Navigate to the location where you placed the Avatars using the navigation options in the upper left.



Once you have located the Avatars, you will be able to see the names and a thumbnail picture of them.



That's it, your done!

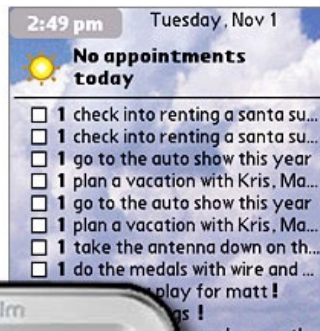
What are PalmOS Backgrounds and how do you use them?

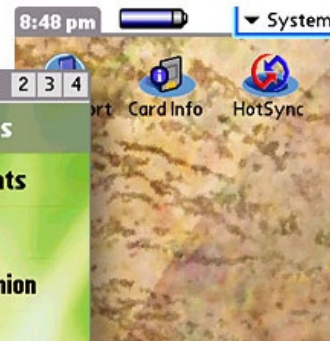
PalmOS Launcher



PalmOS Today Screen

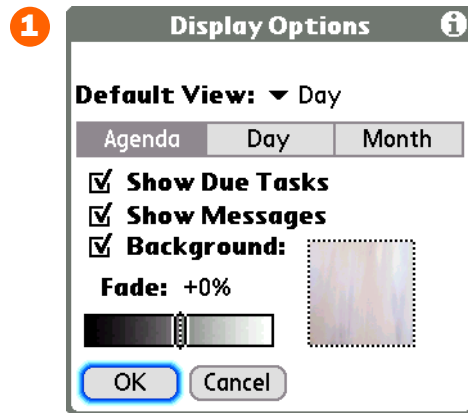


PalmOS Favorites

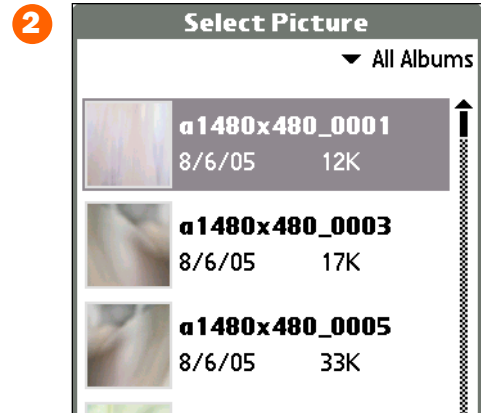


How do you install PalmOS backgrounds?

PalmOS backgrounds are also very simple to install. The first step is to get the backgrounds to your handheld. This requires a Memory Card. Put the backgrounds somewhere on the memory card. Once on the card you will want to use them with any of three programs: the PalmOS today screen, the PalmOS Favorites, or the PalmOS Launcher. The way you choose the background is the same for all three programs. Here is how:



Choose "Display Options" in the "Options" menu. Depending on which program you are in the screens may vary, but there will always be a box with a picture. Click on the box.



Once you have located the backgrounds, you will be able to see the names and a thumbnail picture of them. Enjoy your background.
