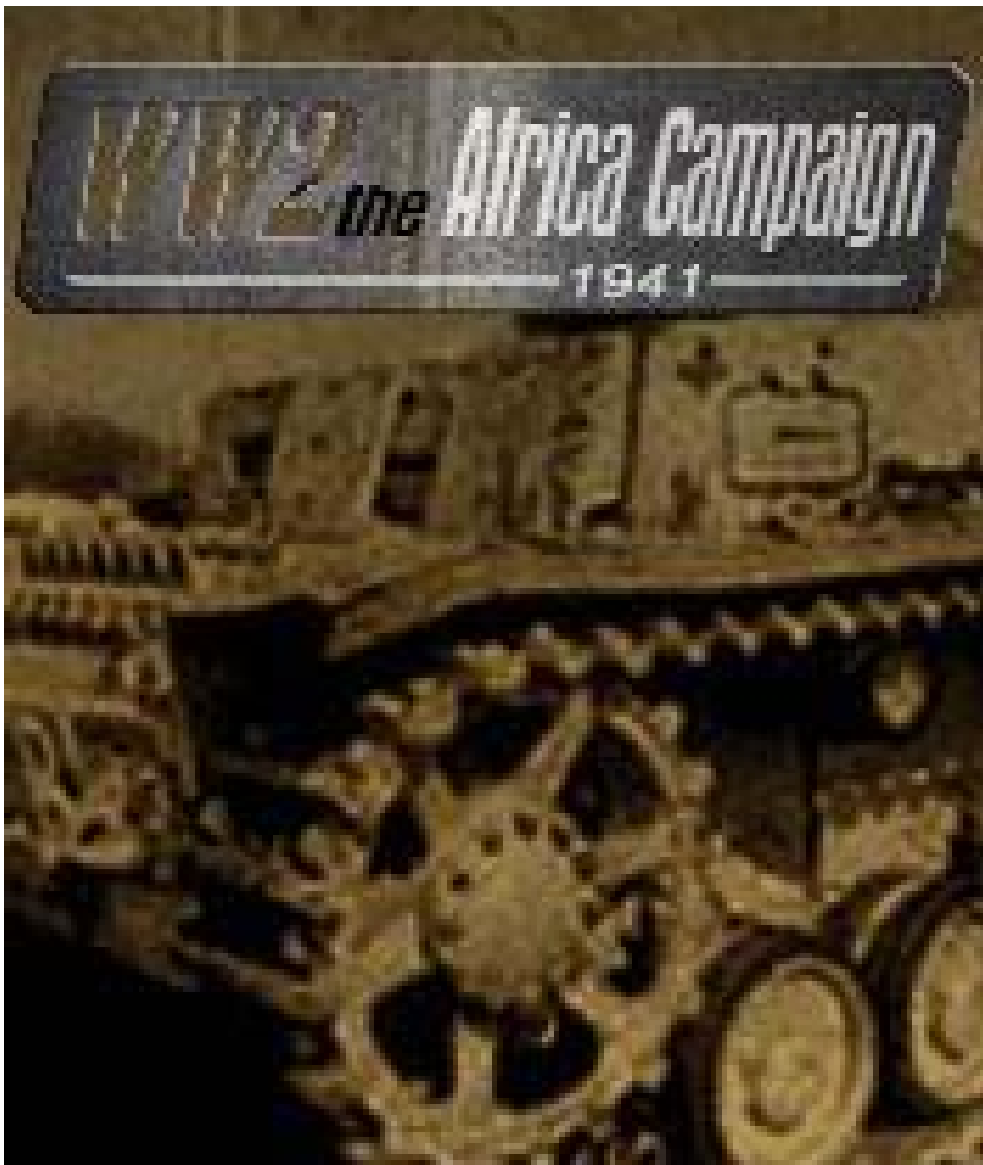

Installation

Hardware and software requirement

MGS WW2: AC1941 requires the following hardware and software to be played properly:

1. 2MB of free memory in the phone or the memory card (such as MMC).
2. MGS (Magic Games Station) Version 2.1 or later.

As an added bonus, your game package will include our newly upgraded MGS version 2.X which allows you to go online and challenge other players from around the world to your favorite games! Once you have successfully registered, you can login, download and play a multitude of MGS online games for free! Note: you will be responsible for data usage fees as charged by your service provider.

NOTE: MGS should be provided along with the game. If this is not the case, the latest version of MGS can be downloaded from the following websites:

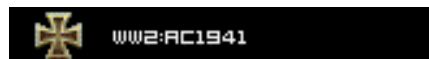
Note: If you are synchronizing the game from your PC, be sure to delete the SMS message in the phone containing the game files after installation. The installation files occupy memory and are not needed after installation.

Install the game

If you have received **MGS WW2: AC1941** on a compact disc provided by your phone provider or downloaded the game from the internet, then follow the installation instructions below. If the full version game is provided to you e.g. on your MMC, then you may go directly to the "Playing **MGS WW2: AC1941**" section.

STEP ONE: Transfer the MGS and game files (*.sis files) from the PC to your phone via IrDA or Bluetooth.





STEP TWO: In your Messages/Inbox, open the *.sis files to launch the installer. Follow the instructions that are automatically prompted during the installation. Be sure to install all the files in the same location.



STEP THREE: Once the installation is successfully completed, you will see a symbol (for MGS) on your desktop. Launching it will bring you to the MGS game list menu. **MGS WW2: AC1941** can be launched from there.

Note: *Memory card e.g. MMC installation is supported, but MGS and the game should be installed in the same driver/location.*

How to register and play the full game

MGS WW2: AC1941 is a shareware and can be downloaded as a free playable demo. The demo mode is limited to only the first mission. The demo version of the game is provided free so you can see and try the game before making a purchase. All missions are available in the full version of the game.

Please follow these instructions to purchase the game:

1. Purchase the game from www.nmprod.com or the websites mentioned previously (Credit card is required).
2. On the purchasing form, fill in the IMEI code of your phone. (The IMEI code is the hardware identification code of your phone and is used to generate the unlock code for **MGS WW2: AC1941**. (You can usually obtain the IMEI code of your phone by typing ***#06#** on your phone in dial mode. In **MGS WW2: AC1941**, the IMEI automatically appears in the REGISTER interface.)
3. Please provide a valid e-mail address. The registration key will be sent to this address within 24 business hours.
4. In the game, select OPTIONS > REGISTER to go to the registration user interface. You can enter the registration code here.

Important: *Please keep your registration code in a safe place. If you lose the registration code and need a reinstallation of the game, please contact Noumena customer support at support@nmprod.com.*

Playing **MGS WW2: AC1941**

Introduction

North Africa, 1941. The Axis have taken most of Western Europe, and now have their sights on the Suez Canal and the Middle Eastern oilfields. If they manage to break through North Africa, the allies will be starved of valuable oil, and this could turn the tide of World War II. In this game, you get to follow three years of armoured battle in the North African desert. Take command of German Panzers, British Infantry tanks, and even the fearsome German 88mm Flak!

Start the game

Once you have launched MGS from your desktop, you will go to a game list and see the following icon:



WW2: AC1941

Highlight this and press the navigation pad or joystick down to launch the game.

After the start screen, you will see the Main User Interface (UI). Use the navigation pad or joystick to choose menu items. Then use the joystick to select or confirm your selection.

- To start a mission

Go to the **Main Menu** UI > select **Missions** > select **Mission name** > review the Mission briefing and press **OK**.

Game play

Steering:

Once you enter the mission, the 'Turn Left' and 'Turn Right' keys are used to control your tank's steering. For instance, most Panzers have three forward gears and one reverse gear. You can use the '[GearTurn Up](#)' and '[GearTurn Down](#)' keys to shift gears.

Firing/Changing Weapons:

Press the 'Mode Shift' key to shift to firing mode. Two additional keys are used for weapons handling. The 'Change Weapon' key switches between your main gun and machineguns. The 'Fire' key will fire the currently selected weapon. You can go back to the game's option menus and change any of the control keys.

Firing Mode



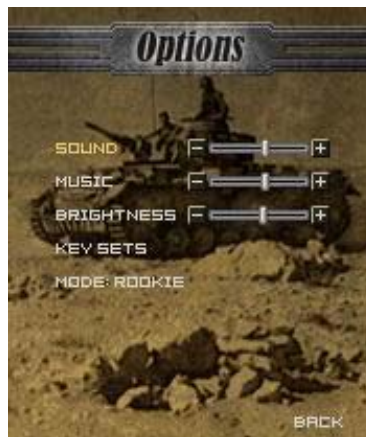


Medals:

Upon completion of a mission, medals will be awarded based on your performance.

Game settings

You can change the game settings by selecting **OPTIONS** in the game's Main UI. The Options UI will allow you to adjust **Sound**, **Music** and **Brightness**, the difficulty **Mode** and **Register** the game. There are three difficulty levels: **Rookie**, **Regular**, and **Veteran**. The higher the difficulty level, the harder it is to complete the missions. Use the joystick to highlight the item you want to select. Then press the joystick to change the selection. Once done, select **BACK** (Right Soft Key) to save the setting and return to the previous UI.
